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## HUNTING/FISHING RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, EXPRESS ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT.

Please read and be certain you understand the implications of signing. Express Assumption of Risk Associated with Hunting/Fishing and Related Activities I, \_\_\_\_\_ do hereby affirm and acknowledge that I have been fully informed of the inherent hazards and risks associated with hunting/fishing activities, transportation of equipment related to the activities, and traveling to and from activity sites in which I am about to engage. Inherent hazards and risks include but are not limited to:

1. Risk of injury from any activity while handling weapons used in hunting, shooting is significant to including the potential for permanent disability and death.
2. Possible equipment failure and/or malfunction of my own or others' equipment which may have been rented, borrowed or personally owned. (All makes and models of firearms)
3. My own negligence and/or the negligence of others, including volunteers, agents, sponsors, independent contractors or representatives of **Brothers-Sisters Of Our Military Adventures and TM & AW Holdings, LLC**, including but not limited to operator error.
4. Discharge of weapons, whether accidental, intentional, or caused by malfunction of the same. It is the responsibility of each person's own safety to wear appropriate personal protective equipment.
5. Hazards related to fishing from a vessel and/or from other fishing sites which include but are not limited to: collision, capsizing, sinking, or other hazards that may result in wetness, injury, exposure to elements, hypothermia, impact of the body upon the water, injection of water into my body orifices, marine life forms, and/or drowning.
6. Cold weather and heat related injuries and illness including but not limited to frostnip, frostbite, heat exhaustion, heat stroke, sunburn, hypothermia and dehydration.
7. Exposure to outdoor elements, including but not limited to avalanche, rock fall, inclement weather, thunder and lightning, severe and/or varied wind, temperature and all other weather conditions.
8. Attack by or encounter with insects, reptiles, and/or animals.
9. Accidents or illness occurring in remote places where there are no available medical facilities.
10. Fatigue, chill, and/or dizziness, which may diminish my/our reaction time and increase the risk of accident.
11. My sense of balance, physical coordination, and ability to follow instructions.
12. Risk of camping/sitting in a blind, to include but not limited to fire, burns, cuts, sun exposure, poisonous plants, insects, food safety, carbon monoxide poisoning, and wild animals.
13. The potential risk of slips, trips, and falls while hiking and getting in and out of any type of building.

I HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE OR OTHERWISE, the following named person or entities, herein referred to as releasees: **Brothers-Sisters Of Our Military Adventures and TM & AW Holdings, LLC.**

To release the releasees, their officers, directors, volunteers, representatives, agents, sponsors, and vessels from liability and responsibility whatsoever and for any claims or causes of action that I, my estate, heirs, survivors, executors, or assigns may have for personal injury, property damage, or wrongful death arising from the above activities whether caused by active or passive negligence of the releasees or otherwise. ## Rules and Regulations

**General Safety:** It is everyone's responsibility for their own safety and the safety of others while taking part in any activity provided by Brothers-Sisters Of Our Military Adventures. ALL WEAPONS will be handled by staff until it is time to shoot. (exception to shotgun related bird hunts). Your personal weapon is allowed however the same rule applies.

All weapons are cleaned and fired prior to the Hunting trip to assure proper sight and care of our weapons. If a personal weapon is used your safety and the safety of others could be at risk be sure your weapon is well maintained. If a weapon looks to be in an unsatisfactory condition you will be asked not to use it.

### Weapon Safety Rules:

1. Treat every weapon as if it were loaded.
2. Never point your weapon at anything you do not intend to kill or shoot.
3. Keep your weapon on safe until you are ready to fire.
4. Keep your finger straight and off the trigger until you are ready to fire.
5. Know your target and what lies beyond.

### Weapons Conditions:

1. Magazine inserted, round in chamber, weapon on safe.
  2. Does not apply unless using a revolver, in which it is ready to fire, on safe and hammer cocked.
  3. Magazine inserted, chamber is empty, weapon on safe.
  4. No magazine inserted, chamber is empty, weapon on safe.
- a. All weapons while transiting will be in condition 3 or 4.
  - b. While in a hunting blind weapons will be in condition 3 and passed over to the service member, the service member will then place the weapon in condition 1 and prepare to fire.
  - c. Any time a weapon is at base camp it will be in condition 4.

These rules for weapons safety are strictly enforced and by disregarding any rule, will end your opportunity to continue your adventure.

### Personal Protective Equipment:

1. Safety Glasses
2. Ear Protection
3. Orange if hiking on premises
4. Clothing/boots need to be appropriate (With the harvest of an animal clothing can be damaged)

It is your responsibility to abide by all state laws and regulations. A Hunting/Fishing rules and regulations book can be found on premises if in doubt of any law or regulation.
